Last Minute Winter Home Maintenance Checklist

Get your winter checklist ticked before the arrival of spring

- Fix any holes in the dry wall and touch up interior paint.
- Check the caulking around sinks and tubs and repair any cracks or damage.
- Remove all shower heads and clean out built-up sediment to improve water pressure.
- Clean out all storage areas and the basement, checking for mould and animal droppings.
- Inspect the roof and gutters to make sure there are no ice dams or icicles. Icicles can be dangerous when they fall and can also water damage the foundation when they melt.
